Killed in action 15th September 1916. Awarded the Military Cross (M.C.) [<i>according to the book but not SDGW or CWGC</i>]. Buried in BERNAFAY WOOD BRITISH CEMETERY, MONTAUBAN, Somme, France. Plot/Row/Section E. Grave 6. Member of the Exchange. Born in August 1883, the elder son of the late Henry Bartholomew. He married in 1907 the youngest daughter of G. W. Share, sister of the Lady Rothmere, and left one daughter*. In 1911 he became a member of the Stock Exchange. He joined his Regiment in February 1915 (sic), and went straight to the French front in the following month. He was killed in September 1916, while in command of the Machine Machine Gun Company of the 2nd Guards Brigade.</p>
