Armorial bearings — Argent, on a bend azure, cotised sable, between two horse-shoes of the second, a unicorn's head erased or between two bezants, a crescent for difference gules. Upon the escutcheon is placed a helmet befitting his degree, with a mantling azure and argent ; and for his Crest, upon a
