2 years prior military service with Officer Training Corps. Eldest son of the Rev. John Prince Fallowes, M.A., and Agnes K. V. Fallowes, of Heene Rectory, Worthing, Sussex. Brother of Katherine H. Angela Fallowes, Mary Agnes Fallowes and Richard Prince Fallowes. He was educated at Haileybury College and Cambridge University. While at Cambridge University, he served in the Cavalry Officer Training Corps. Living in Canada when war broke out, he enlisted as a Private in the 4th Battalion, C.E.F. As such, he came to England with the first Canadian Contingent and was one of the first from the contingent to obtain a commission in the British Army. As a Lieutenant in the 9th Battalion, Suffolk Regiment, he entered the France / Flanders theatre of war, going up to the front in August 1915 and seeing action at the Battle of Loos. A former commanding officer wrote of him 'he is a very good and hard working officer, full of energy and always ready for any service of danger'.
