General Notes:

Father (born St Petersburg 1 Sept 1861 - all his father's siblings born there) connections with a British Merchant Company, "Hubbard's" (Egerton Hubbard & Co.) in Petrograd, Russia, resided there at the time of his son's death and until at least Oct 1917 [SR]. Returned to UK on or before 1925 when he was living with Mary Emily FIELD in Hammersmith, London. [Electoral Roll]. Death notice on 8 Nov 1949 describes him as "Rev George Forbes Feild, late of St James' Church, West Hampstead and formerly of Petrograd, Russia, aged 88 years".
