Mr. Arthur Thomson Glegg (M.A., Aberdeen, 1880 ; LL.B., Edinburgh, 1884), advocate, Sheriff-Substitute of Lanarkshire at Glasgow, died at his residence, 17 Athole Gardens, Glasgow, on 4 January, aged fifty-four. He was called to the Scottish bar in 1883 ; was appointed Sheriff-Substitute of Renfrew and Bute at Greenock in 1901 ; Sheriff-Substitute of Lanarkshire at Airdrie in 1905 ; and one of the Sheriffs-Substitute at Glasgow in 1909. He was the author of a well-known and authoritative work on " The Law of Re-paration " and of a standard manual on the Workmen's Compensation Act, and was a contributor to the " Encyclopaedia of Scots Law ".
