Matthew Kirtley. In 1869 he was placed in charge of the running sheds at Lincoln and subsequently held a similar position at Leeds for five years. He became locomotive running shed foreman at Kentish Town in 1880, and in 1885 he was appointed locomotive superintendent and resident engineer of the Metropolitan Railway from 1 July 1885 following Tomlinson. Jackson notes that he was relieved of his duties for permanent way from 1 December 1891 and resigned on 31 October 1893. He was followed by T.F. Clark. Hanbury then joined the Cape Government Railway as **inspecting engineer for all rolling stock manufactured in England**, and held this appointment until his retirement in 1920.
