24th June 1916. M.C. to Lieutenant Charles Richard Tisdall, Special Reserve (attached 1st Battalion, Irish Guards): "For conspicuous gallantry. When on patrol with two men he discovered a strong enemy patrol, who evidently intended to rush an isolated post. With great determination he dispersed the enemy patrol with one of his men, after sending the other for reinforcements. His promptness in all probability saved the post."

TISDALL, CHARLES RICHARD, born 1893, baptized 10 March 1893, Highbridge, Somerset, son of the Rev. Alfred Oliver Tisdall and Evelyn Susan Empson. His father was Vicar of St Saviour's, Belgrano, Buenos Aires, from 1896 to 1914. Last Employer - Forestal Land, Timber & Railways Co.

TISDALL, MICHAEL HENRY, born 1888, eldest son of the Rev. Alfred Oliver Tisdall and Evelyn Susan Empson. Royal Air Force, 48th Sqdn. His father was Vicar of St Saviour's, Belgrano, Buenos Aires, from 1896 to 1914. Killed while flying at Quetta 23/12/1919, buried in Quetta Govt. Cemetery 2272. Last employer: River Plate Trust, Loan and Agency. Commemorated DELHI MEMORIAL (INDIA GATE).
